

## **HIBBA NEWS 23/4/2014, R-1**

**HIBBA Pennant Round 1 was played on Wednesday 23/4. There were some very close games and there some not so close games. Also there was a forfeiture.**

**In Division 1, Cobden 1 were a home to Scotts Creek 1 in a very tight game early in the match that saw Allen Armistead's Cobden team of Sandi Johnstone, Ron and Joy Hill skip away from Peter Baker's Sotts Creek team Neville Robb, Jan Hutchison, Noelene Richards. They were 10 all on the end 15 then Codden put the foot down and won 6 of the last 7 ends to be victorious by 10 shots, 22/12.**

**Cobden 2; Bazil Hammond [s], Glen Cain, Doreen Coverdale and Claire Reynolds were to good for 2013 Pennant winners Camperdown 1; Fred Salmon [s], Harvey Robbins, Gary Body and Marjorie Burnett as they won 12 ends to 9. Cobden 2 led most of the game and broke away after the end 11 when Camperdown 1 knocked kitty off for 3 points. Although Camperdown got 1 shot on the replay Cobden won the next 2 ends to give them a lead of 9 shots. Cobden then held Camperdown out to win by 8 shots; 23/15.**

**Camperdown 2; Ron Cameron [s], Ron Absalom, Harry and Maria Vansomeren travelled to Timboon Lawn,; Arthur Finch [s], Joe Clover, Brett Mungean and Jean Clover, where they couldn't quite get over the home team finishing with a 4 shot difference in a low scoring game. There was only one that there was more than 2 scored. Timboon Lawn scored a 4 on the 16<sup>th</sup> end and that was the difference between them. Final score 18/14.**

**Laang-Ecklin 1; were at home at the Hall to Glenormiston 1; where they held an 11 shot advantage at games end; 27/16.**

Although Cobden won 8 ends, 7 singles and a 3 earning them 10 shots. Camperdown won 13 ends with only 2 singles, the rest were multiples including a 7. Final score 36/10.**

**Cobden 4, Allie Long [s], Graeme Woodmason, Margaret Boyle and Kath Walsh, were holding a game until the last bowl against Simpson 1 Lydon Rogerson [s], Maria Seabrook, Murray Lucas and Gwen Crole. Lydon managed to draw the shot with his last bowl to win by 2 shots; 20 / 18.**

Simpson shot away to a 10 nil lead on the first 4 ends but Cobden came back to be within one shot 12/13 on end 13. Then Simpson went to a 5 shot lead with 4 ends to go, but not to be denied 5 to 1 to be one shot down on the last end and just couldn't keep their winning shots on the last end.
