**Pennant Grand Final Notes**

These three finals were not as close as expected as they had rather large winning margins that were so different from when they played earlier in the season.

Division Two was the closest match of the night between Camperdown 3; Ron Simcox (S), David Coverdale, Joyce Horan, Val Coverdale, and Cobden 3; Glenn Cain (S), Claire Reynolds, Bazil Hammond, Margaret Hester, with final margin being five shots.

It was a good battle between the two leaders of each team and the next two team members of each side struggled with the speed and draw of the mat. The star of the match was the Camperdown skipper who converted many losing heads to his team's advantage time and time again. Camperdown scored 1, 2 and 3 to lead 6/0 on the third end and were never headed after that. Cobden were just not able to keep Ron out as Camperdown raced away to a 12/2 lead on end 8. Cobden had a couple of big little ends on the next 2 short ends with a two and a five, but Camperdown proved to be equal to the task as they went to win seven ends to four, to win 21 - 16, with Ron not having to play his last bowl.

Division Three was also won in the second half of the game as Timboon-Lawn 3; Clarrie Matthews (S), Arthur Felmingham, Hazel Collins, Aub Fimmell held a lead of 12/4 on end 9, only to drop 7 shots on the next two ends to be one up against Camperdown 7; Cliff Newling (S), Jill Rantall, John Morgan, Brenda Willis, on end 11.

Then Clarrie and his team took over and won seven of the last ten ends to win for the third time against Cliff's top team during the season.
