

## HIBBA News Round 5

Only 5 rounds gone now and only team, Camperdown 2 is undefeated at this time with the 2 Laang-Ecklin teams barking at their heels in Division 1. Cobden has just entered the top four with a good win over Laang-Ecklin 1.

Wiridjil 1 have a slight advantage, 2 points, from Camperdown 3 in Division 2. Cobrico 3 and Simpson 2 sit on top of Division 3.

### Division 1
