Round 3 Pennant

After round 3 there are only 3 teams of the 30 teams in the Association that are undefeated. They are Camperdown 2 in Division 1, Wiridjil 1 in Division 2 and Cobrico 3 in Division 3. One more is undefeated with 2 wins and a draw in Division 2 namely Scotts Creek 2 were one of a pair of draws in round 3. Pennant Secretary Ron Hill has now produced the ladders from the 3 rounds finalised so far.

DIVISION 1:-

DIVISION 2:-
